

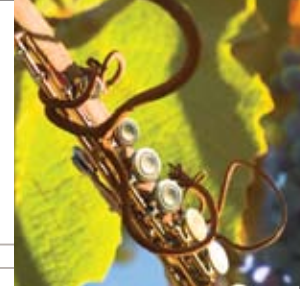
THE CADENZIA ENSEMBLE *celebrating excellence and individual expression of McLaren Vale Grenache.*
